Dear Mr. Rivela,

This is in response to your recent inquiry regarding the above-referenced complaint. We have reviewed this matter thoroughly and we believe that this issue was, in fact, appropriately resol ved some time ago.

In Mr. Byington's complaint, he acknowledges that his son opened an account with BMG Music Service using a credit card belonging to a Karen Patterson. Mr. Byington then had himself added as either an authorized user or joint account holder on Ms. Patterson's credit card account.

Mr. Byington states in his complaint, "It seems that on 2004-10-08, Chase issued credits to our account for the entire \$2075.89 via charge backs to BMG." BMG did receive those charge backs on October 14, 2004 and processed them accordingly. As a point of information, we had previously credited some of those charge backs, resulting in a double credit to Mr. Byington's credit card account. So Mr. Byington has been made more than whole. We, on the other hand, have not. We do not, however, intend to pursue this matter further. As a point of information, though, we will certainly not permit Mr. Byington or anyone associated with this credit card to re-open an account with us.

Further, based on Mr. Byington's description of the use, or rather, misuse, of his and Ms. Patterson's joint credit card by a third party apparently known to them, it might be appropriate to su ggest to Mr. Byington and Ms. Patterson that they be much more careful about who has access to their credit cards in the future.

Mr. Byington's son's account with BMG Music Service is closed with a zero dollar balance. We believe that this matter was appropriately handled and consider the matter closed.
